REPRODUCTIONS FOR STUDY OR RESEARCH PURPOSES

PHOTOCOPIES: the reproduction in photocopy of modern books is allowed, complying with the current law regulations (L. 633/1941 and further modifications), and provided that the procedures are appropriate to ensure the conservation of materials.

Inside the library: B&W photocopier self-service (service provided by a firm): re-usable 'count-down' card. To obtain permission of copy, ask for the authorization at the lending desk.

From off the library: ask for quotes to Reference service. Prepayment is required, on post account or bank transfer; when the receipt is send via email, fax or email, the copies are shipped by mail.

DIGITAL PHOTOS AND SCANS: are set up inside the Library. Service with charge.

FOR PUBLICATION AND COMMERCIAL PURPOSE

The permission is granted by the library director, according to current law regulations (D. Lgs. 68/2003; D. Lgs. 42/2004, art. 107). Information about rules and charges in Manuscripts reading room or by email.

HOW TO GET

From Railway Station – by walk (km 1,5) heading to Corso del Popolo, then to Corso Garibaldi, to left Riviera Ponti Romani, cross Galleria S. Bernardino and enter via S. Biagio – by TRAM SIR1 direction south capolinea GUIZZA, get off at PONTI ROMANI, cross Galleria S. Bernardino and enter via S. Biagio

by car from Autostrada A4 (exit Padova Ovest) enter via Po, go on Cavalcavia Camerini, Car park in via A. da Bassano (charge due); tram station in piazzale Borgomagno.

WHEN YOU ENTER

- ✓ Store bags, backpacks, PC/tablet's covers, folders and container of any kind in the lockers (free service, key operated service); clear plastic bags are available for free inside use; large items of luggage or other belongings exceeding the locker size not allowed
- ✓ pick up and fill in the 'carta d'entrata' (i.e., day access pass)
- ✓ no food or beverages; allowed to bring in bottled water, except in Manuscripts Reading Room
- ✓ the entire Library is a no-smoke area; phone call and any other activity but study not permitted
- ✓ no pets or animals allowed, except trained animal for people with disabilities

The **BIBLIOTECA UNIVERSITARIA DI PADOVA** is a state public library under the authority of the **Ministry of Culture**. It was founded in the year 1629 as the library of the University of Padua, whose holds significant historical evidences. The library is accessible by everyone and cooperates to the local library system. The collection contains over 700,000 works, among them 2,758 manuscripts, 1,589 incunabula, about 10,000 16th century editions.

Application for library card and card renewal.

Number of borrows: up to 2 works, and a total of 4 items; are excluded books printed before 1900; manuscripts, rare books; in bad conditions, miscellanies, journals, reference material, etc.

Loan lasts: 30 days. Renewal: 1, of 30 days; you can request it the last day, at the lending desk, or by phone, or operating in the web area "My library card". No renewal is possible for overdue items, or if another borrower has requested the item.

The use of the items checked out is not-transferrable. In case of overdue materials, the borrower is immediately suspended from the service; in case of damaged (even with marks) or loose item, a replacement copy or an amount of money for the purchase is due.

APPLICATION FOR LIBRARY CARD

In order to apply for the library card, you need:

- 1- resident citizens in Veneto region passport-size photo (in colours or B/W; also on common paper) and valid ID (passport, driving licence...);
- 2- residents in other Italian regions, Republic of S. Marino, Vatican City, EU countries, ALSO documentation about your study or research needs (student card, employment contract...), and about your stay (hall of residence, apartment...) in Veneto;
- 3- non-EU national, ALSO permesso di soggiorno (residence permit) granted by a Questura in the Veneto region.

The library card must be presented at every request of borrowing. The expiry date is at the end of your study, research or work period, and in any case no more than 12 months.
